Welcoming both LGBTQ+ prospecting parent/s and LGBTQ+ identifying youth is essential to creating an inclusive and safe environment during the adopting/ fostering process.

LGBTQ+ prospecting parents experience multi-level barriers (legal, adoption agencies, fostering/birth parents, and child) that makes it challenging and discouraging to continue (Goldberg et al. 2019).

Therefore, when it comes to adoption and fostering for LGBTQ+ parent/s, it's important to find agencies that are LGBTQ+ friendly to make the dream of being parents come true.
